


## POWER UP!

110 Volt Spa: Plug the GFCI cord into the designated wall outlet. In about 24 hours, you'll be ready to soak.

220 Volt Spa: After a licensed electrician installs power, turn on the breaker in the hot tub subpanel. Enjoy warm water in just 6-8 hrs.

Keep the hot tub plugged in & turned on with the cover in place. Your hot tub temperature is self-maintaining, like a refrigerator, so you don't have to!

**TIP:** Use +/- buttons to adjust the temp. After 5 seconds, the current temperature will appear & climb degrees until it gets to set temperature.



TIP: Press the Jets button on your control panel to start jets.

Buy test strips to use to check chemical levels. Add

spa with water.

Fill hot tub until the water is 1" above the highest jet, but not more than 6" below the top of the hot tub.

CLEAN UP!

Protect yourself & your hot tub

with these tips:

Buy chemicals to help sanitize your hot tub & balance PH, total alkalinity, & calcium hardness.

Run jets at high speed for 15 minutes.

**TIP:** Remove door panel to check for leaks.

To get the water level just right:

Turn on water & wait.

• Replace filter after filled.

TIP: Add sanitizer (chlorine or bromine) & potassium monopersulfate (MPS) shock weekly with the high-speed pump activated. Run jets for 15 minutes with the cover off to circulate the water & clean all over.
